CHBC Meeting at Riverdale Baptist Church – Logistics Guide

We are thankful for the generosity of the congregation of Riverdale Baptist Church who are hosting us for our main weekly services for the next two months. This document is designed with two purposes in mind. First, it should help you know what to expect so you can be prepared and so that our services can go as smoothly as possible (1 Cor. 14:40). Second, it is designed to help you decide if you can and should join us. There are many reasons why some members of our congregation should not join us, especially those of you who see yourselves as higher risk for COVID-19. Hopefully as you see what precautions we plan to take and which precautions we do not plan to take, you can make an informed decision about whether or not to come. You should feel free in your conscience not to join us if that seems to be the wisest course of action. The sermon audio and a video of each service will be posted on the website following the service as usual.

If you or any member of your household have been sick with symptoms the CDC has associated with COVID19, please refrain from attending for at least 14 days unless you have tested negative. Additionally, please do not attend if you or a member of your household has been diagnosed with COVID19 in the 14 days prior to a service. Anyone who is exhibiting symptoms will be kindly asked to leave.

We plan to start our service at 5pm and conclude by 6:15pm.

Getting There

Address: We are meeting at Riverdale Baptist Church at 1177 Largo Road, in Upper Marlboro MD.



Driving Directions: (From Capitol Hill) Drive East on East Capitol Street which becomes MD-214. After crossing the 495, turn right on MD-202. At MD-193 (entrance to Watkins Regional Park), turn right into the church and follow the map to the left. (495 from points North) Take the MD-202 exit. At MD-193 (entrance to Watkins Regional Park), turn right into the church and follow the map to the left. (495 from points South) take exit 13 to Ritchie Marlboro Rd. which becomes White House Rd. Turn right on MD-202. At MD-193 (entrance to Watkins Regional Park), turn right into the church and follow the map to the left.

Public Transportation: take the blue line to Largo Town center and then the 21 bus to Riverdale Baptist School.

Parking

- Use the parking lot shown on the map above.
- Double-Parking: We will not be double-parking any of the lots. Please do not park anyone in.

What to Bring

Face Coverings: PG County has made the wearing of face coverings mandatory in public spaces with a few exceptions. As such, we ask all who are attending this gathering without a medical exemption from their doctor to wear a face covering that covers both nose and your mouth for the duration of the time they are on Riverdale Baptist Church's property unless inside a private vehicle (adults and children except those aged two or younger).

Bible: Please bring your own Bible as we will not have pew Bibles with us. We will be providing bulletins. Alternatively, you can download or print your own at www.capbap.org (see where to pick up bulletins below).

Children: we cannot provide any childcare at this meeting, but all children are welcome.

Bulletins and Communion Elements: you may pick up bulletins in either lobby after you enter the building.

Singing: we will be ending our service by singing several hymns indoors. We've designed the service this way so that those who feel less comfortable with indoor singing can leave after the sermon.

Seating: inside the church, every other pew will be blocked off to maintain a distance of six feet between pews. Both the main level and the balcony will be available for seating. *Please sit with one household or group per section of pew*.

Nursing Mom's Room: room C1, across the hall from the auditorium.

Distancing: please remain at least six feet from all individuals not in your household.
